**HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT** – Dave Hartman

Dave reviewed the bids for the Alexander Road Bridge. The consensus of the Committee was to award the bid to Silverline Construction for a total of \$181,238. Dave will have a resolution for Monday's meeting.

Dave reported the last vehicle that was to be sold this year has been sold for \$6,200. This brings the total revenue from the sale of equipment to \$57,800.

**BUILDINGS & GROUNDS** - Joe Reed

Joe reviewed the Weights & Measures report.

Joe reported the yearly Fire Alarm Inspections were completed in November at the County Office Building and Courthouse. The current contract expires at the end of this year and Red Hawk has given a proposal under state contract for a three year contract at a cost of \$7,790 annually. Joe will have a resolution for Monday's meeting.

Joe reported he has requested quotes to paint the four columns on the front of the old courthouse. The lowest price was Golden Painting at \$2,800. Joe will have a resolution for Monday's meeting.

Joe reported the NRG Curtailment Solutions program that we have participated in for years has changed the standards for participation. The County's generator does not meet the new standard for emissions controls due to the ages. This will decrease the revenue for Public Works by \$2,500. Joe was asked to look into options to bring the generator up to the new standards.

Joe reported the County Attorney continues to look into the issue of a contract longer than 5 years.

Joe reported the intake that took in snow during the last snow storm has been raised 24 inches which should take care of the problem.

Joe reported in November the elevators were serviced and a fire drill for the County Office Building was held.
