

SPECIAL SESSION – THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2017

The Yates County Legislature convened in special session Thursday, February 16, 2017 at 4:30 pm. Chairman Dennis presided with Legislator Morris absent.

RATIFYING LABOR AGREEMENT WITH CSEA

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining teams for the County of Yates and the CSEA Union have concluded negotiations for a successor collective bargaining agreement covering the period of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2020 for the CSEA bargaining unit,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yates County Legislature hereby ratifies said agreement and authorizes the expenditure of the necessary funds therefor, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Yates County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the County, and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be given to the CSEA Union President, the County Administrator, the County's Labor Attorney and Personnel Officer.
