### **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT** – Dave Hartman

Dave reported the supply of county road maps is getting low and questioned if the Committee wanted him to reorder. Dave was asked to come up with figures as to how many we have ordered in the past and approximately how many we sell in a year and bring this back to Committee next month.

Dave reported PESH was on site the 15<sup>th</sup> and did a walkthrough of the Benton facility. Some minor issues were found, some of which have already been taken care of. Dave expects the official letter within the next 2 or 3 weeks.

Dave reported paving is all done and thanked Craig for going out and supervising the projects.

Dave reported there is enough money left from paving to pay for the timber bridge components for Valley View. The abutments are already in place. Dave will do a budget transfer when needed.
