**Sheriff – Ron Spike**

Ron reviewed the following resolutions that would be needed. The Committee approved.

- Authorization To Establish Trust And Agency Account For The Yates County Sheriff Office Appropriate Evidence And Property
- Authorize Chairman To Sign Agreement With Finger Lakes Radio Group
- Authorize Sheriff To Renew Hyper-Reach Agreement for PSAP
- Authorize Sheriff To Sign MOU With Dundee School For 2017-2018 School Resource Office (SRO) Services

Ron reviewed statistics for the month of May.

Ron reviewed the Jail Population report: Yates County-30, Federal -14 for a total of 44. Of these there are 35 males and 9 females.

Ron reviewed the Revenue report which shows \$159,129.99 has been collected so far this year. \$300,000 was budgeted.

Ron reported there are only 3 individuals in the SWEAP Program.

Ron reported there has been issues with the Velocity security causing constant UPS issues. Ron is working with IT on this.

Ron reported he applied for a legislative grant last fall. Ron stated Senator O’Mara’s office had contacted him and told him he was awarded a \$35,000 grant.

Elden suggested that discussion take place on the public safety building as far as the issues that are coming up such as roofs, gates and so on. County Administrator Lawton explained there is a Committee setup now to review long range capital planning. The Committee currently consists of Joe Reed, Dan Long, Dave Hartman, and the County Administrator. County Administrator Lawton hopes to have something ready for the Legislature as far as long range projects within the next year.

Mark and Elden would like to see a committee start working on analyzing the Public Safety Building now.

Doug suggested to have another analyzes done like the Kimball Study and put money in next year's budget.

Ron explained he did a memo a couple of years ago when the shared services were being discussed he would redistribute that memo.

Administrator Lawton suggested that he reach out to the National Institute of Corrections (NIC) to looking into the Public Safety Building issues. There would be no cost to the county. The consensus of the Committee was to go ahead with NIC.
