*(if the container is empty it should go in the garbage, do NOT register these materials)*

### **NOT ACCEPTABLE**

Large Kitchen Appliances (other than microwaves), Broken TV's or Monitor Tubes

## **TIRES**

Cars and Light Truck Tires Only (on or off rim)
